

GEOGRAPHICAL SPREAD


This map shows the geographical spread by county of surname Elwood in Great Britain. For example you can see below that over 5 % people whose name is Elwood live in **West** Yorkshire.




Note; Ulster has *Elwood*.

In the above distribution one can see a strong Cumbria influence for the name *Ellwood*.




This map shows the geographical spread by county of surname Ellwood in Great Britain below that over 5 % people whose name is Ellwood live in Lincolnshire.
